SUBJECT: 2017-2018 MBAO/YBC ROOKIE TOUR

The Master Bowlers' Association of Ontario would like to inform you of the 2017-2018 "MBAO/YBC ROOKIE TOUR". Our goal in offering this Rookie Tour is to give your YBC Seniors the opportunity to join our Members at one or more of our events and see if they would enjoy becoming a member of the MBAO after they graduate from YBC. This is like having a test drive before they have to commit to becoming a member. It is our hope that we retain these young players and that they will remain with your YBC programs as instructors carrying on the knowledge that they have learned while being a part of your program.

For the 2017-2018 season the Rookie Tour will be offering tournament stops for the YBC Senior bowlers to participate in five (5) different Master Bowlers Association tournament events in a Pins Over Average or Scratch category. Players who would like to participate at an event in both the POA and Scratch format may do so for a small additional cost.

A GENERAL YBC ROOKIE TOUR TOURNAMENT RULES

- <u>Dress Code</u>: To maintain the dress code appearance and discipline of the Master Bowlers' Association all YBC Seniors <u>MUST</u> wear <u>BLACK DRESS</u> <u>PANTS</u> and <u>MUST</u> wear a YBC identified bowling shirt, MBAO Rookie Tour Shirt, any other MBAO Shirt or a plain golf shirt with no other logos or insignia. Shirts must have a collar and short sleeves. <u>NO Yoga Pants are allowed to be worn.</u> No hats are allowed. Wearing of headphones or ear pieces for electronic devices other than for medical reasons is prohibited during MBAO events.
- <u>Registration for All Rookie Tour Events</u>: Entries for MBAO events will be restricted to YBC Seniors up until the week before the event in order to allow the master bowlers to register for the event. At that time all open spots will be filled on a first-come-first-served basis up to the maximum number of entries allowed for each event. <u>WALK-IN REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED</u>.
- <u>Waiver Forms</u>: It is the policy of the Master Bowlers' Association of Ontario to request that all YBC seniors participating in any Provincial Finals of MBAO events as well as any events for the 2017-2018 YBC Rookie Tour must complete a waiver form prior to bowling in the events. The waiver form can be downloaded from the MBAO website at www.mbao.ca on our YBC page. This waiver form is in accordance with the requirements of our insurance policy.

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B YBC ROOKIE TOUR "AGGREGATE" ELIGIBILITY AND BURSARY AWARD

For the 2017-2018 season, as passed at the 2014 AGM, the MBAO will continue with our aggregate program for the YBC Rookie Tour. Any YBC Senior who will be participating in the Rookie Tour events will be automatically tracked for the aggregate. To win the aggregate and the YBC Bursary Award, YBC Players must participate in at least 3 of the 5 POA or Scratch Events including the Mandatory Mid Winter Blues Event. YBC players who do not compete in the Mid Winter Blues will not be eligible for the Aggregate or Bursary Awards.

This award is open to ALL YBC Seniors. YBC Seniors may only win one Bursary Award. If they win the Bursary and continue in the YBC they cannot win a bursary award for the second time.

The Bursary Awards for 2017-2018 will be a \$500.00 award the YBC Player may use towards any Tournament Events in the MBAO as a member.

Bursary Award winners have 4 years from the time they finish YBC to use their award. They must also meet the age eligibility requirements for the MBAO.
